




About Fala Brasil

Description of the school and practise

- Fala Brasil's classes employ and innovative, dynamic and interactive methodology which combines traditional grammar with neuro-linguistic exercises. The student takes in the theory of the course in a practical way; before having the chance to complete their learning by way of interaction with Brazilians in a variety of real-life situations.

Description of the school and practise

✓ The course begins with introductory classes for students who have recently arrived in the country. These include vocabulary, simple grammatical structures and specific knowledge aimed at enabling day-to-day language survival. The goal here is to allow for efficient communication in a variety of situations and to provide a basic idea of daily life. With the acquisition of "survival skills" the learner begins the learning phase relating to culture and information about Brasil (habits, culture, behaviour, history etc). The following module then focuses on classes of specific interest chosen by the learner. These include, journalism, art, tourism, Brazilian music and literature, amongst others.

The total course length is 80 hours (theoretical) and 20 hours (practical)

Classes focused on specific interests

- ✓ Theoretical and practical classes including:
- Cultural and linguistic immersion in main areas of Brazilian life that makes international headlines, such as Carnival, favelas, Olympic and Paralympic Rio 2016 Games, amongst others.
- Practical classes focused on the student's fields of study. They may include interviews; reports production; developing touristic activities; artistic, literary and musical production, and more.
- Theoretical classes covering vocabulary, grammar and cultural/social understanding relevant to the subject.

- Presentation of the students' creations to other students, to everyone involved in YNSR program and to Brazilians who will be invited.





Content 2nd WEEK - BASICS (Knowledge about Brazil/ Unterstanding Brazil)

✓ 4 hours per day of theoretical classes, from Monday to Friday

4 hours of practical classes over the week:

Wednesday, 12:30-2:30pm: lunch followed by a conversation with the cook, a waiter and a kitchen's assistant.

Friday: Attend a music concert and make an interview with the musicians.







CONTENT - 3rd AND 4th WEEK - INTERMEDIATE (focused on specific interests)

✓ 3rd week: 4 hours per day of personalised theoretical classes, from Monday to Friday.

6 hours of practical classes over the week:

- Tuesday, 2-5pm: Interview a "sambista".
- Thursday, 2-5pm: Visit Samba city and interview employees.
- ✓ 4th week: 4 hours per day of personalised theoretical classes, from Monday to Friday.

6 hours of practical classes over the week and final presentation:

- Tuesday, 2-5pm: Favela tour with a social and political approach, including an interview with the local residents.
- Thursday, 2-5pm: Interview with the workers of the Olympic and Paralympic Committee.
- Friday, 2-4pm: Final presentation
